Library hours are Monday thru Friday 2:00 pm – 7:00 pm and Saturday's from 9:00 am – 3:00pm, unless otherwise posted.

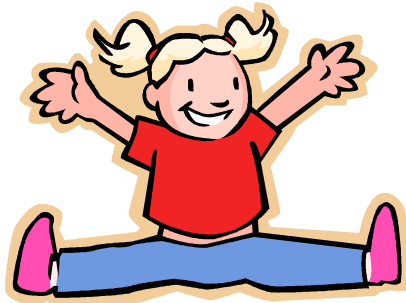
