Policy 4300 STATUS: ADOPTED

HIGH SCHOOL LEAVING CEREMONIES (formerly GRADUATION)

Adopted: January 12, 2000

Last Revised: June 19, 2013; March 11, 2015

Description:

The Board of Education recognizes and supports high school leaving ceremonies and other school-sanctioned events properly supervised and endorsed by the school administration.

Each school will establish dates, locations and other logistical matters with parents and students during the school year to ensure that school-sanctioned leaving events can be safe, orderly and successful. Professional and support staff will be encouraged to support these events.

Each year the Superintendent will inform the Board of the dates for the school leaving ceremonies and activities of each secondary school in the district.

Regulation 4300 STATUS: ADOPTED

HIGH SCHOOL LEAVING CEREMONIES (formerly GRADUATION)

Adopted: October 10, 2006

Last Revised: June 19, 2013; March 11, 2015

Description:

The school-sanctioned events must have the following elements in place:

- i) adequate adult supervision
- ii) no alcohol or drugs allowed
- iii) provision for adequate security in consultation with the RCMP.

Any events that require the use of any school district facility, grounds or equipment must be school-sanctioned and properly supervised.
