CUSTODY OF STUDENTS

Board Approved and Codified: February 24, 1986

Description:

The Board of Education directs that all schools shall guard and protect the legal custody and identity of students in attendance in our schools.

- 1.
2. A school (principal, head teacher, teacher) shall not give custody of a student to any person whatsoever, except to the custodial parent/parents or legal guardian, unless specifically authorized in writing by the custodial parent or legal guardian
3. A school (principal, head teacher, teacher) shall not give names, addresses or other pupil information to anyone except to the custodial parent/parents, legal guardian or to those persons specifically authorized in writing by the custodial parent or legal guardian.
