MURAL PAINTING ON SCHOOL WALLS

Description:

The Board of Education recognizes that school beautification programs can:

- Improve school spirit among students and staff;
- Contribute towards a positive school tone;
- Promote pride and ownership in the school building.

With this in mind, the Board supports the tasteful development of murals on school walls.

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Description:

Regulations to be followed when a person or a class proposes to paint a mural on a schoolroom wall:

- 1. The proposal must have principal's approval.
- 2. The design of the mural must be presented to the Parent Advisory Council and approved by the Superintendent for recommendation to the Board of Education.
- 3. The project must have Board approval before proceeding.
- 4. The District's Maintenance Department must be consulted to:
 - i) Ensure the safety and compatibility of paint to be used;
 - ii) Develop a plan for preparation of the surface to be painted;
 - iii) Discuss strategy for minimizing disruption to students;
 - iv) Obtain the best possible price for the product.
