#### Description:

The Board of Education recognizes that school beautification programs can:

- Improve school spirit among students and staff;
- Contribute towards a positive school tone;
- Promote pride and ownership in the school building.

With this in mind, the Board supports the tasteful development of murals on school walls.

Description:

Regulations to be followed when a person or a class proposes to paint a mural on a schoolroom wall:

1. The proposal must have principal's approval.
2. The design of the mural must be presented to the Parent Advisory Council and approved by the Superintendent for recommendation to the Board of Education.
3. The project must have Board approval before proceeding.
4. The District's Maintenance Department must be consulted to:
  - i) Ensure the safety and compatibility of paint to be used;
  - ii) Develop a plan for preparation of the surface to be painted;
  - iii) Discuss strategy for minimizing disruption to students;
  - iv) Obtain the best possible price for the product.
