OUR PURPOSE

UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT

- Teasing, name calling, unkind or foul language
- Physical violence or intimidation
- Theft, vandalism, or damage to property
- Illegal acts (drugs, weapons, etc.)



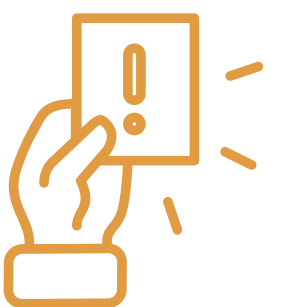
DRESS CODE

- Wear appropriate clothing for a positive learning environment.
- No violent, offensive, or discriminatory messages on clothing
- Footwear required at all times

WE EXPECT STUDENTS TO



- Be kind, include others, and use manners
- Cooperate with adults
- Use respectful words and listening skills
- Keep our school clean and tidy



CONSEQUENCES

- Focus first on restorative actions (repairing harm, making apologies)
- Consequences increase with age, maturity, and repeated behaviour
- May include: reflective breaks, phone calls home, loss of privileges, restitution, counselling, or suspension



OTHER SCHOOL RULES

- No cell phones, smart watches, or personal electronic devices during school hours both inside and outside on school grounds
- No energy/caffeinated drinks, smoking, or vaping
- Walk when inside the building and use quiet voices
- Stay on school property unless given permission to leave
