The Learning Services Department has just wrapped up an internal audit of all of the Category H students across the district. This audit is to ensure that this group of students is receiving the supports they need to be successful.




In Aboriginal/Indigenous Education, the Tripartite Agreement AGM was recently held. The Learning Enhancement Agreement (LEA) Oversight Committees also met. Each First Nation band has an LEA, each committee developed their own terms of reference. Indigenous Advisory Committee meetings have been held at schools across the District. Each school has gathered data and created a goal in alignment with the LEA.
