Description:

The Board of Education believes that a School Based Team (SBT) model is an essential support structure for students.

The purpose of the SBT will be to review the circumstances for students who are encountering particular difficulties in any aspect of their school life, and who may require additional learning or support services. The SBT will connect the student, parent(s) and staff with additional services as deemed appropriate to support the student. The Board believes that through connecting students to services, a SBT is integral in supporting students to be successful.

The Board therefore requires that each school develop a School Based Team model.

SCHOOL BASED TEAMS

Last Revised: April 2013

Description:

A School Based Team will be developed in each school in a model that supports the learning culture of the school. The intention of the SBT is to develop support strategies and facilitate services to students.

With that in mind Principals will, on an annual basis:

- identify who will participate on the SBT;
- determine a schedule for meetings of the SBT;
- communicate how students will be referred or have access to the services of the SBT;
- maintain minutes/notes of each meeting;
- articulate and promote the purpose of the SBT.

Principals will report annually the development of their SBT to the District staff responsible for student services.
