- National Indigenous day June 21st. There will be a celebration at South Peace from 430-630pm. We're going to be making dream catchers at the school and Serena Brent is going to help us make Bannock.

- New staff for next year: Mrs. Giesbrecht taking over Ms. Kurjata's class. Miss Hommy taking the grade 4/5/6/7 class. No one has taken the principal position yet.
