### **Before And After School**

A reminder to parents to park away from the bus lanes. Most students are dismissed through the west side doors near the portable and there is gravel parking on that side. For parents who have students dismissed out the front doors, there is also parking available on the east side towards the rink.

Our hallways get very crowded after school, so we ask that parents wait for their children outside of the school. If you need to speak with a teacher, you are welcome to come in once the majority of students have exited. This also gives teachers time to ensure their students have everything they need and are on their way safely.

As in other schools in the area, unless it is an inside day, students are expected to keep their backpacks outside until the bell rings. They may keep their backpack with them or place it by their class line-up cone. Inside mornings occur when the temperature is -20.

*Inside Shoes: All students must have inside shoes with non-marking soles. As our floors can get very wet when it rains or snows, they may also want to have spare dry socks in their backpacks.*

*Signing In and Out at the Office: If you need to leave early or arrive late, please make sure you sign in and out at the office so we know who is here.*

### **Grade 5/6/7 Class**


