Dear Parents and/or guardians,

The month of April has come and gone and learning at Tremblay Elementary still goes on. As these unprecedented times continue, so does learning for our Tremblay families. We wanted to take the time to update you on some important information regarding continuation of learning and report cards for Tremblay Elementary students. In addition, Welcome to Kindergarten and Ready, Set, Learn events this month!

Continuity of learning:

Teachers are continuing to plan for student learning. Each week, work packages are created and are available in hard copy or online. Work packages are picked up by appointment from tables located at the main entry of the school. Completed student work may be dropped off at the school on the tables outside. Teachers have also supplemented work packages with online meetings and interactions using zoom, classroom dojo, google classroom or Freshgrade. If you require any information on how to login to these online apps, please contact your child's teacher.

Grades and report cards:

Students will be receiving final report cards for the 2019 – 20 school year. Students will continuously receive feedback on any and all assignments that are turned into their classroom teachers during this unprecedented time. Work completed this term is meaningful and may be considered when determining a final letter grade.

Primary students will receive a continuum grade (not yet meeting / developing / meeting / exceeding) for the year on their final report card that indicates student progress in Literacy, and Numeracy for the 2019-20 school year. Final continuum grade on this report card will be largely based on work presented in terms 1 and 2. Teachers may change a grade in these subject areas if work completed this term provides ample evidence to do so.

Intermediate students will receive a year-end report card. Students will have third term comments and final letter grades for the subject areas of Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies. Final letter grades will be largely based on work presented in terms 1 and 2.

Teachers may change a final letter grade in these subject areas if work completed this term provides ample evidence to do so. All other subjects will have a final letter grade based on work presented in terms 1 and 2.

Welcome to Kindergarten and Ready, Set, Learn:

The Welcome to Kindergarten and the Ready, Set, Learn events at Tremblay will take place on Wednesday, May 27th. The Ready, Set, Learn is available to children ages 3-4. We will be contacting parents of children that are already registered to begin Kindergarten this fall in order to explain what this event will look like, and times for parents and children to come to the school.
