

Pouce Coupe Enhanced Safety Measures

Entrance and Exits

- We will continue to have staggered recess and lunch times, separating primary and intermediate classes
 - Primary Recess: 9:47-10:02 Lunch 11:32 (outside first 15 min.)
 - Intermediate Recess: 10:05-10:20 Lunch 11:32 (inside eating first 15 min)

- Dismissal times will be staggered to reduce crowding at the end of the day:

- Students will line up in their designated spots before school and when coming in from breaks
 - Mr. Lam's class Kindergarten door
 - Mr. Pott's class West doors
 - Mrs. Schlauwitz's class West doors
 - Mrs. McKenzie's class Gym doors
 - Ms. MacRae's class Gym doors
 - Ms. Holland's class West doors
- Breakfast Club will continue to provide nutrition each morning in the gym. Students must wear a mask while entering the gym and only remove it for eating.

Washrooms

- Mr. Lam and Mr. Potts both have washrooms located in their classrooms for student use.
- West end washrooms (new washrooms) will be used by Miss Holland's and Mrs. McKenzie's classes
- Mrs. Schlauwitz's and Ms. MacRae's classes will continue to use the central (old) washrooms

Learning Space Arrangement

- Spaces are configured to maximize space between people and avoid people directly facing one another

Gatherings

- Staff gatherings (meetings, etc.) will occur virtually
- School gatherings (assemblies, etc.) will occur virtually

Hand Hygiene

- Hand cleaning facilities are available and accessible throughout the school.
- Each classroom contains a sink
- Students will wash hands before class, each time they enter the building, and before eating

Daily Health Checks

- Parents and students are reminded of their responsibilities to complete a Daily Health Check
- Staff and students are reminded to stay home when they are sick
- Arrangements will be made to send students home if they develop symptoms at school

Masks

- Everyone at school (without exemptions) wear masks in accordance with the PHO Order on face coverings
 - Times when students may remove masks:
 - When outside
 - When doing intense physical activity
 - When eating or drinking (while seated)
 - When directed by a teacher for learning activities
- Teachers will ask students to put on masks as they enter the building
- We will work with those with mask exemptions to explore potential strategies to reinforce and enhance other safety measures
- Masks are available for those who have forgotten theirs
