We're also looking for parents with their Food Safe certificates to be able to serve hot lunch to the students. I.e. hotdogs, special luches.

Just a reminder, that if the busses aren't running on a hot lunch day, hot lunch will not be served. If you drop your child off at school, please make sure to send them with a lunch. If your child is absent on hotdog day, we will credit your Munchalunch account for the hotdog.

## School Fees & Permission Forms

#### <u>Bus Notes</u>

If your child is not riding the bus home at the end of the day, it is important to send a note, call the school (leave a message) and call the bus garage to notify the bus drivers about any changes. This includes letting us know if someone other than a parent is picking up your child. The school bus garage number is 250-782-2106. Students who do not have notes from parents indicating a change will be sent home on their regular bus.
