Changes Are Coming for 2023-2024

During student teacher interviews, teacher handed out pamphlets that discussed changes to the way we report on student learning. These changes will go into effect for the 2023-2024 school year.

One of the big changes will be that grades K-9 will be reported on using a provincial proficiency scale. The scale will be as follows:

Emerging	Developing	Proficient	Extended
The student demonstrates and initial understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.	The student demonstrates a partial understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning.	The student demonstrates a complete understanding of the concepts and competencies relevant to the expected learning. Students in grades 10 - 12 will continue to be reported on using letter grades and percentages.
