BIKES/SCOOTERS

Anything that your child rides to school must be walked on **all** fields, around buildings and playground structures.

Also, please use a bike lock to ensure items are not stolen.

OFFICE CALLS

To help Mrs. Dell at the office, it would be helpful if you planned with your child or children ahead of time about what they are doing after school. Often, the office has anywhere from 10-15 messages to try to get to students within a span of 5 minutes as parents call 'just to remind them'. We understand that emergencies and changes come up so there is an absolute need for messages to be delivered, however, if non-emergency calls could be kept to a minimum, that would be extremely helpful! **"MAIN PARKING LOT"** we need parents to pull into a spot and park. By "parking" your vehicle to let your child out rather than driving through the parking lot and letting them jump out, this will prevent others from inadvertently backing up without seeing someone being dropped off.

If you want your child to wait in the vehicle with you until the bell goes, do not use the main parking lot. This is for drop off purposes only. Use Willow Street or the cul-de-sac off Spruce Street if you would like to wait with your child.
