

PARENTS AT SCHOOL

If you are coming to the school, please check in at the office. Anything being dropped off should come to the office to minimize interruptions in the classrooms.

PLAYING OUTSIDE

Weather permitting, we will be having fun in the snow. Please be sure that your child is dressed for cold weather: winter coat and boots, mitts, hat, scarf and snow pants.

Safety of Students (Including Higher Risk Activities) Regulation 4555.10.3 tobogganing.

If your child wants to participate in tobogganing/sliding, we will have an area dedicated for sliding down the hill with toboggans/sliders. Students who want to use sliders/toboggans need to bring and wear a CSA helmet for safety. The helmet must be appropriate for winter, eg. hockey, skiing, snowboarding, not bike helmets.

NEW REPORTING ORDER

Report cards are changing this year to align with the curriculum and to help ensure that every student in the province is set up for success in their learning. You may remember getting a letter grade or percentage at the end of a chapter in your textbook or after a test, signaling to you that learning had come to an end. Today we know that learning doesn't stop when students hand in an assignment or complete a test. That's why students in kindergarten to Grade 9 will receive marks on a four-point proficiency scale, instead of receiving letter grades starting this school year. Students in Grades 10-12 will still receive a letter grade and percentage to support their entry into post-secondary education. Report cards for all students will now also include self-reflection and goal setting, as well as descriptive feedback.

These changes mean that report cards may not look the same as when you were in school or may look different from what you received for your child last year. However, you can trust that the information you will receive will provide a complete picture of what your child can do, where they need to improve, and how you can support their learning.
