BC New Reporting Standards

Report cards are changing this year to align with the curriculum and to help ensure that every student in the province is set up for success in their learning. Today we know that learning doesn't stop when students hand in an assignment or complete a test. That's why students in Kindergarten to Grade 9 will receive marks on a four-point proficiency scale, instead of receiving letter grades starting this school year. Students in Grades 10-12 will still receive a letter grade and percentage to support their entry into post-secondary education. Report cards for all students will now also include self-reflection and goal setting, as well as descriptive feedback. Students will or have already brought home a pamphlet outlining these changes.
