

Code of Conduct

The appearance of any young person is primarily the responsibility of the child and his/her parents. This appearance should not be distracting or offensive to teachers or other students. Nor should it be detrimental to the educational atmosphere of the school. When a student's appearance is felt to be negatively distracting, he or she will be asked to get changed or to cover up. A parent meeting with administration may be requested. Staff in conjunction with parents, has agreed that the school will maintain the following dress code.

Students are **not** to wear attire that:

- advertises drugs or alchohol
- displays offensive, inappropriate, or explicit pictures or language
- is too revealing such as: short shorts, or short shirts
- expresses vulgar language, racist or sexist comments
- is sleepwear (pajama bottoms), unless it is part of spirit week
- covers their heads unless it is for religious reasons, this includes hats, and hoodies

OFFICE CALLS

To help Mrs. Dell at the office, it would be helpful if you planned with your child or children ahead of time about what they are doing after school. Often, the office has anywhere from 10-15 messages to try to get to students within a span of 5 minutes as parents call 'just to remind them'. We understand that emergencies and changes come up so there is an absolute need for messages to be delivered, however, if non-emergency calls could be kept to a minimum, that would be extremely helpful!

"MAIN PARKING LOT" we need parents to pull into a spot and park. By "parking" your vehicle to let your child out rather than driving through the parking lot and letting them jump out, this will prevent others from inadvertently backing up without seeing someone being dropped off.

If you want your child to wait in the vehicle with you until the bell goes, do not use the main parking lot.
