

Pick-up/Drop-off Parking Lot Safety

We recognize that the parking lot and traffic pattern for pick-up and drop-off at EFR is not ideal in accommodating the large volume of traffic for a school our size. This causes delays and stress for parents/students and staff of the school. We continue to work toward improvements. One of the options we do have available for those that can pick-up/drop-off students quickly is our back lot, off 10st.

Another limitation is the lack of street parking. However, if you are able to arrange a pick-up/drop-off spot on one of the side streets, please consider this as an alternative to trying to find space in our parking lots.

The most significant area of potential danger to students is the lane entering the main parking lot from 92nd Ave. Not only is this lane meant to stay clear for emergency services, but it is also a primary crossing for students being dropped off and walking to school. We ask that no one stop or park for any reason along the metal barrier as you enter the lot.
