## **PARENTS AT SCHOOL**

If you are coming to the school, please check in at the office. Anything being dropped off for students should come to the office to minimize interruptions in the classrooms. When signing your child out please note we have added a parent signature spot to the form.

## **SCOOTERS/BIKES**

Before school students need to walk their scooters/bikes when they step into the parking lot or onto school property. There is a bike rack behind the school by the shed where students should be parking their bikes and scooters. If students cannot lock their scooter up there, they should ask their classroom teacher to store it in the classroom. After school students are expected to walk their scooters/bikes to the crosswalk and walk them across the crosswalk. They are then free to scooter/bike away.
