Please remind your child(ren) to cough into their elbow, use a tissue and wash their hands regularly.

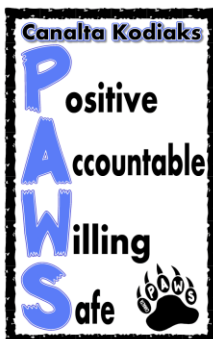
