

Family Weekly Memo- May 4-8, 2026

Believe it or not, there are only 8 weeks of school left!

This week is Emergency Preparedness Week. At assembly on Monday we will be talking about Emergency Preparedness and through the week we will be practicing a number of drills. We will have our last fire drill of the year (if all goes well) on Monday. Tuesday we will have an Earthquake Drill. Wednesday we will have a Secure and Hold drill. We also have a plan in place in the event we need to evacuate the school and reunify parents with students. I've attached a letter explaining that process. It is very important that your contact information and emergency contacts are up to date in our files.

Earthquake Drill:

Mrs. B will make an announcement that we may be experiencing an earthquake and ask people to drop, cover, and hold on. In classrooms students will drop to the ground, move under a table or desk, and hold on to the table legs until shaking subsides. Once the shaking has stopped the teacher will count for 60 seconds and then move the class outside to the Muster area.

Secure and Hold Drill:

This may be necessary if there is an incident occurring somewhere close to the school and it has been deemed by Emergency Services that students need to remain inside the school. Classes will carry on as usual, teachers will secure the classroom doors, and the outside school entrances will be locked.

Mrs. B will announce that we are entering a Secure and Hold. Teachers will ensure their classroom doors are locked and the outside school doors will be locked. Once a reasonable amount of time has passed Mrs. Bougerolle will lift the Secure and Hold and the day will resume as normal. The outside door will be unlocked at this time. If you arrive at the school during the Secure and Hold drill the front door will be locked.

Please discuss these drills with your kiddos at home. They are not meant to scare anyone but only to prepare and practice in the event we ever have to use them.
