How to View / Print Learning Updates (Report Cards)



Step 1:

Log in to your MyEducation BC Parent Portal Account.

Step 2:

Look for the “Published Reports” section on the right-hand side. (Shown in the screenshot below with a red arrow pointing to it).

Step 3:

In the Published Reports section, under the “Filename” column, you will see a PDF called “Learning Update”. Click on that and the Learning Update (Report card) will open in another window.

Step 4:

You can now download the PDF or print it.
