5/6/7 Mrs. Nikita Tree nuts, lemon.

There will be no food in common areas of the school to help avoid any accidental exposure to allergens. If a student accidentally brings an item with an allergen they will be able to eat their food in Mrs. B's office and then wash up well after. We want to ensure all students are safe at school. If your child has an allergy we have not identified in the above list please let us know asap.
