Elector Registration

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in one of the above mentioned electoral areas for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors will also be required to produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **and** proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if applicable, written consent from the majority of the property owners.

Mail Ballot Voting Opportunity

Voting by mail ballot (and elector registration by mail in conjunction with mail ballot voting) is available to qualified electors who:

- (a) have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity; or
- (b) expect to be absent from the electoral area on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities.
- (c) person(s) who reside in remote areas within the jurisdiction designated as School District No.59 (beyond 50 kms in driving distance from the nearest voting station).

A person wishing to vote by mail ballot must apply by giving their name and resident address (non-resident property electors must provide address of property in relation to voting) to the Chief Election Officer or designate during the period beginning at 8:00 a.m. on October 3, 2018 and ending at 4:00 pm on October 18, 2018. It is the responsibility of the elector to ensure that the ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer before 8:00 p.m., the close of voting on general voting day, October 20, 2018.
